



Dear Parents and Guardians,

Cambridge Public Schools is participating in a federal program available to select schools as part of the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Program called the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP). In a CEP school, all students receive a nutritious breakfast and lunch at no cost, regardless of family income.

**Cambridge Rindge and Latin, all upper schools (CSUS, PAUS, RAUS, and VLUS), Fletcher Maynard Academy, and Kennedy Longfellow qualify for the CEP program.**

- If your student(s) does not attend a CEP school, you are encouraged to fill out a Free and Reduced-Priced Meals Application for your family if you believe you will be eligible based on income.
- If you have students at both CEP and non-CEP schools, it is recommended that you fill out a Free and Reduced-Priced Meals Application for your household.
- If your child transfers from a CEP school to a non-CEP school during the school year, you are encouraged to complete a Free and Reduced-price meal application.

*ALL students in MA continue to receive meals at no cost for the entire 2022-2023 school year, regardless of CEP or income status.*
